

**IN RE: APPOINTED PROCESS SERVERS**

In order to improve the standards and practices for private process service in the Fulton County Superior Court, appointments for permanent process servers shall be approved once a year by the Chief Administrative Judge of the Fifth Judicial Administrative District. Such appointment shall remain in place for a period of one year in 2012 and for a period of two years after persons seeking appointment have completed the certification training provided by the Administrative Office of the Courts of Georgia. To receive a subsequent appointment, an official application must be completed with the Superior Court.

All permanent process server appointments conferred by Fulton County Superior Court prior to October 1, 2011 will expire as of December 31, 2011. Permanent Process Servers may renew their appointments beginning October 1, 2011 through December 15, 2011 by submitting the required application. A single order of appointment for all permanent process servers will be established and filed with the Clerk of Superior Court.
