



KEEPING JURORS SAFE

YOUR SAFETY IS OUR PRIORITY

Fulton County's judges **appreciate your jury service** and want you to know the steps being taken to keep **jurors safe**.

Our first floor courtrooms are large enough to maintain at least six feet of distance between occupied seats. Courtrooms and juror areas have been outfitted with MERV-11 air filtration systems. Jurors summoned and serving will be limited in number to accommodate CDC distancing guidelines. The entire facility will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected before your arrival, hand sanitizers will be provided, and social distancing will be maintained at all times. Please wear a face mask and, if you wish, gloves while in the building.

Many of you who have received this summons are not familiar with jury service. Jurors are selected at random and not everyone who received a summons must serve. You will receive all the information you need during the selection process.

Please **complete the online juror questionnaire** and review the **COVID-19 screening questions** as promptly as possible.

If you have a hardship preventing you from serving, you can send a request to have your service postponed or excused to Jury Services at info.juryservices@fultoncountyga.gov. The judge will review your request.

Thank you for your jury service! Our system of justice depends on citizen participation, and **your health and safety** are the priority of Fulton County courts during your service.
