



A Message from Jury Services Regarding COVID-19

The Fulton County Courts want you to know that juror safety is our priority when you report for your upcoming jury service. For the safety of everyone, we are encouraging members of the public to follow COVID-19 health and safety protocols as outlined by state and local health agencies (fultoncountyboh.org) and the CDC (cdc.gov).

Here is some of what we're doing to protect our jurors and staff members during the pandemic:


- (1) Masks are required to board the juror shuttle bus and everywhere inside the courthouse
- (2) Reduced numbers of jurors are being called to serve
- (3) The County's maintenance crew is regularly cleaning all touchpoints around the courthouse
- (4) MERV-11 air filtration systems have been installed in every courtroom
- (5) Hand sanitizer stations are now located throughout the courthouse
